Based on the performance in the B.E./B.Tech. of JEE(Main)-2020, number of top candidates as per the requirement for JEE(Advanced)-2020 will be eligible to appear in JEE (Advanced)-2020, Admission to IITs will be based on category-wise All India Rank (AIR) in JEE(Advanced), subject to the conditions as would be mentioned in JEE(Advanced)-2020 Website.
